1. Create an original project or essay.
2. The Rules: This work must be an original project for this scholarship, and should not appear on the internet or be distributed in any other form of publication prior to August 2020.
 - **Research using at least one *print* source and one *non-print* source. Only use sources that are **grade-appropriate** and **reputable**.**
 - No Wikipedia or textbooks.
 - Forget plagiarism. We check.
 - ***Bibliography is a must with any form of presentation.***

3. The Presentation Choices (Choose ONE submission format):

A. Written Work

- Typed work of two or three pages or handwritten work of four or five pages.
- **Plus** one-page bibliography of sources
- Follow MLA format.

OR

B. Creative Presentation

- This can take many forms: video, audio, slide presentation, photo timeline, graphic novel, etc. (*Only choose one style.*)
- We're pretty much open to any type of creative project. However, it has to be a substantial piece of work. For example, a ten-page PowerPoint presentation should contain rich content in an informative and appealing style. (It will *not* suffice to have one or two sentences or bullets per slide. If you are relying on the features of PowerPoint or another electronic media to make an appealing presentation, be sure to also keep details, details, details of your content in mind.)
- For all creative presentations **please submit a paper copy** and a file on CD, thumb drive, scan disk, etc. (if applicable). These items will not be returned, so don't send expensive ones.
- **Plus** one-page bibliography
- Follow MLA format.

4. All presentations will be used only for *Kingdom of Lucerne* scholarship purposes. They will appear nowhere else by our hand.

CHECKLIST

Topic Requirements:

Your project concerns **one** of these early settlements of our country:

- Henricus in Virginia
- New Amsterdam in New York
- Popham Colony in Maine
- St. Augustine in Florida.

- 1) Write a personal diary from the viewpoint of someone who might have lived in the early days of the colony.
- 2) Don't use a real person.
- 3) Do include the name, age, and occupation of the diary writer. The occupation has to be one that was known to be done in that colony. Make sure to have information on your occupation in the diary.
- 4) Be sure to include real events that happened in the colony (and your diary-writer's reaction to them) as well as fictional events that could have happened to your character.

Project Type: (Choose only ONE)

A. Written Work

- If you type this, it must be at least two pages of written word.
- Even though it is a diary, follow MLA format concerning footnotes or endnotes.
- Pictures, drawing, and bibliography increase the amount of pages
- Handwritten papers should be at least four pages if the paper is 8 ½ x 11". Adjust length as necessary.
- ***It has to be legible.***

OR

B. Creative Presentation

- Create a visual representation of the diary.
- This could be as simple as a narrated film of the diary being written or visual representation of your actual hand-written diary (This is different from hand-written papers.).
- You can use props, costumes, etc. for a video.
- You can also use various filming techniques or PowerPoint features to make your project stand out.

Checklist for all Project submissions

- Did you stay on the topic?
- Did you cover who, what, when, where, and why? *Details!*
- Did you **exclude** Wikipedia and textbooks as sources?
- Is your bibliography included with **at least one print source and one non-print source?**
- Include a copy of official transcript with grades of A or B in history and English in 11th & 12th grades
- Copy of Acceptance letter at a college or university
- Include a paper copy **and** a file on CD, thumb drive, scan disk, etc. if project is a creative submission*

- Optional:* Include resume of activities at school and community
